
Marling School Strategy for Covid-19 recovery and Pupil Premium 2020-2023



Teaching

- Emphasis on Marling Teaching Framework as a tool to structure effective teaching & learning.
- Focus on collaborative learning strategies, particularly through Google Suite for Education.
- Reading Comprehension strategies through whole school literacy programme in KS3.
- Further development of reading planned through focussed tutor time (2022/23)
- High quality approaches to assessment and feedback that lead to mastery learning. Delivered through newly established Marling Framework CPD sessions



Targeted academic support

- Targeted catch up intervention in English & Mathematics for identified Y7 students.
- Create new TLR role to provide more effective support and monitoring by designated member of staff, particularly of key student groups.
- Exam support and intervention, focusing on revision skills and techniques.
- Peer mentoring and coaching through coordinated and targeted programme
- Literacy intervention whole school programme
- Establishment of 'Marling Promise' to ensure that PP students are supported through pro-active provision of academic resources, as well as extra-curricular opportunities

Wider strategies

- Expanding staffing capacity to support social and emotional wellbeing.
- Further developing approaches and tools for communication to enhance parental involvement and engagement.
- Re-establishment of a strong and diverse extracurricular programme
